Have you ever wondered how many gymnasts actually compete in your discipline or how many gymnasts compete in your level?

>>> We've compiled some charts to answer some of your questions. These numbers were taken as of August 2008 from the USA Gymnastics database. The numbers represent all gymnasts in each discipline that actually compete (or perform for General Gymnastics) at USA Gymnastics sanctioned events.

Check out the competition and see what numbers of gymnasts you're up against. But, before you check out the charts and graphs on page 34, see how smart you are. Take the quiz and see what you know!

Remember, these numbers don't include all of the kids that do recreational and preschool gymnastics. These numbers are just those athletes registered with USA Gymnastics who compete or perform and have a USA Gymnastics member number.

ANSWERS

#1. C. Women's Gymnastics has the largest number of athletes with 68,797 followed by men with 12,072.

#2. D. In Women's Gymnastics, Level 4 has the most participants with 21,766 followed by Level 5 with 16,856.

#3. True. There are more elite competitors in men's gymnastics (136) than in women's gymnastics (79).

#4. A. Trampoline and Tumbling has the largest numbers in its program followed by Group Gymnastics, Rhythmic, and Acro Gymnastics.

#5. B. In women's gymnastics, the largest number of Level 10's can be found in California (149), followed by Pennsylvania (127), Illinois (106), New Jersey (86), and New York and Florida (84 each).

#6. B. California has the largest number of rhythmic gymnasts (330), followed by Illinois (141), New York (91), and Florida (67).

#7. B. Missouri has the largest number of Acro gymnasts in its state with 244, followed by Maryland (115), Texas (106) and Louisiana (68).
